The CEREC allows the doctor to take an image of a patient’s tooth and produce a porcelain crown or restoration that is identical to the real tooth in color, texture and appearance, even to feeling hot and cold temperatures like the original tooth. The cost is very reasonable, compared to the two-appointment process. In fact, it is done in about the same time as used to be spent just on prep work!

The CEREC can also handle permanent onlays or veneers. Because of the way materials are bonded to your tooth, Dr. Crumpton can save as much healthy tooth tissue as possible. CEREC tooth restoration is not just convenient, it also a healthy process. What a wonderful gift to give to someone you care about!

The office uses digital X-rays, which not only use less radiation, but also allow the doctor and patient to see all the details more clearly. With the intraoral camera, patients feel part of the process as they view the photographic images taken.

“We offer pre-op sedation options for fearful patients,” assures Dr. Crumpton. Patients can listen to music, or watch movies during the procedures. After a pleasant experience at the hands of a caring dentist, the fear is gone and they will have a reason to smile.

Today’s veneers can give a “face lift” to a damaged or discolored tooth with little or no discomfort. Veneers are thin, but strong porcelain “shells” are permanently bonded to the surface of the teeth with a strong resin adhesive. They look natural, and are often less expensive than alternative procedures. In many cases, Dr. Crumpton can get the permanent restoration completed the same day.

Even a subtle change in your smile can make a difference in how you look and feel. An attractive, healthy smile will give you the confidence you need in both your personal and professional life.
